
Learn a different language

Beat Your Own Drum Make a home movie!, Perform in public!, Look in the mirror every day and smile, Scrapbook from your past.


Thrive Start a blog, Meet someone doing your dream job!, Teach someone a new skill, Meet an Artist!




Activity Pack

How to play 'Heads up!'


This game is great to play as a family or with two. On the blank cards write down a famous figure or a character from your favourite show.

After you have done this pass the card to another player and get them to hold the card on their forehead. It is important that the player does not look at the card.

The person holding the card asks questions about who the character could be and the questions can only be answered with a simple Yes or No!

Once the player has guessed the famous figure or character they win the round! Make sure you keep a tally of who has won each round.
